Defect: The gas product does not meet Australian regulations due to incorrect specifications: The threaded component may be difficult to connect to a butane canister.

Only micro-stoves that bear DOM and the inlet air hole as detailed above are affected. Other batches of micro-stoves without the inlet air hole are not affected.

**Hazard:** Gas can leak for longer than the expected short burst when screwing onto the canister. If this occurs near an ignition source, the released flammable gas may ignite resulting in a fire or serious illness, injury or death.

What to do: Stop using the product and return it to their nearest Macpac retail store for a refund. In addition to a refund, Macpac is offering customers a \$20 store voucher upon returning the product.

If it is not safe to return it to a Macpac retail store under Covid 19 restrictions, mark the product "DO NOT USE" and store securely until it is safe to return it to the nearest Macpac retail store.
